The Parks

Animal Kingdom

- Opens Early and Closes Early
- Bus or car transport only
- 30 minutes early entry for select guests
- Lots of shade
- Pandora and Navi River Rapids

Hollywood Studios

- Same Hours as Majic Kingdom
- Not a lot of shade
- Skyliner, Bus, and Car for Transport
- Early Entry for select Disney Hotels
- Has Galaxies Edge - Rise of the Resistance



EPCOT

- Opens last but stays open late
- Early Entry for select Disney Hotels and Extra Magic Hours for select Disney Deluxe Hotels
- Some but not much shade
- Bus, Monorail, Skyliner, and Boats

EPCOT (Cont.)

- Divided into two parts
 - Future World
 - Guardians of the Galaxy (Maybe)
 - World Showcase
 - May be boring for younger children
 - Frozen and Remy
 - Fantastic Food

Magic Kingdom

- Early Entry for select Disney Hotels and Extra Magic Hours for Select Disney Deluxe Hotels
- Likely biggest crowds
- Monorail, Bus, and Car transportation
- Iconic Park - It has the Castle, many character viewing opportunities, and all the mountains

Tickets

- Base ticket is \$109 for a one day ticket
- Park Hopper is a \$80 add on
 - May not be worth it, you can only hop after 2:00
- The more days you play, the more you will save

Park Reservations

- To control crowds in light of the COVID-19 pandemic Disney requires park reservations.
- The way this works is that, before your trip, you will reserve the parks you want to go to online through your My Disney Experience account.
- You can park hop, if you bought that option, after 2:00 without a reservation.

Gennie +, DAS Pass, and Rider Swap

Giene + and Individual Ride Pass

- Giene +: replaces the old fast past system where you can reserve a place in line for a shorter wait in a given window
 - Costs \$15 per guest per day
- Individual Ride Pass: For select rides, you can buy a ride reservation providing a decreased wait time in your ride window.
 - Costs fluctuate but can be as much as \$15 per day
 - You can purchase two of these per day per guest

DAS Pass

- DAS stands for Disability Access Services.
- Disney is clear that this is for people who are unable to wait in lines.
- It entitles a person holding the pass and several others in their party to reserve a return time equal to the current wait time on a ride.
- Once they return they wait in a significantly reduced ride.
- It is good because you are not in line but bad because you miss the pre-show.

Rider Swap

- This ensure that everyone in a party can ride a given ride even if a member of their group cannot
- Simply ask a cast member for a rider swap and they will give you a plaqard on a lanyard, you and whatever children can ride the ride wait in line and do so while another adult waits with the children who cannot
- When the first adult has finished, they take the plaqard to the front of the line where they, and whatever children can ride the ride, are wicked to the front of the line.

Where to Eat

Types of Restaurants

- **Snack** - Popcorn, Dolewhip, Mickey Bar
- **Quick Service** - Food is purchased at a counter and taken to a table to eat
- **Table Service** - A traditional dining experience (with a waiter or waitress). These also include buffets.
- **Signature Dining** - Disney has several Fancy restaurants that are a one of a kind experience.

ADR

- With so many good places to eat at Disney it seems hard to pick... But you have to.
- 60 days in advance you can, and should, reserve any table service meals you want to eat.
- Disney is not seating large groups at this time. Large parties will have to split up at multiple tables using multiple reservations.
- There are no time restraints on reserving Disney Springs Dining

Animal Kingdom

- Flame Tree BBQ - Quick service BBQ restaurant that is always a hit.
- Tusker House - Table Service with amazing bread service

Hollywood Studios

- ABC Cafe - Quick Service cafeteria style with tons of indoor (air conditioned) seating
- Hollywood and Vine - A table service restaurant featuring a buffet with beef tenderloin

EPCOT

- Les Halles Boulangerie-Patisserie - Quick service French pastries
- Biergarten - Table service German buffet with a dinner show of a traditional band.

Magic Kingdom

- Columbia Harbor House - A quick service establishment where you can feast on lobster rolls and other reasonably priced seafood.
- Cinderella's Royal Table - Pricy but a one of a kind experience; Eat IN THE CASTLE as various princesses come to your table.

Disney Springs

Disney Springs

- An outdoor eating, shopping, entertainment, and hotel district on Disney property
- Serviced by boats and busses
- Hotels in this area are very close to the action

Transportation

On Site

- When on Disney property, transportation is provided free of charge
- All forms of transportation run just frequently enough but it will take a bit of time to get to where you want to go
- Sometimes a big part of the fun is getting there (e.g. the boats to Disney Springs)
- Bus, Monorail, Small Boat, Large Boat, and Skyliner

From the Airport to Disney

- Mears Connect
 - The company that provided Disney Transportation for years
 - \$32 / adult and \$27 / child round trip
- The Sunshine Flyer
 - Themed
 - \$34 / adult and \$25 / child round trip

Always Available

- Taxis
- Rideshare
 - Lyft has *Mini* vans
- Rental Cars
 - Parking is extra



Hotels

Disney Hotels

- There are tons to choose from each with different theming
- Divided into value, moderate, and deluxe (based on price and amenities)
- You will get the greatest Disney experience and some extra perks but you will also pay for those.

Disney Good Neighbor Hotels

- The hotels are approved by Disney and guarantee a minimum standard with respect to amenities and transportation (this may cost extra)
- Typically, you can expect early access to the parks and a good location but you should always check with the hotel to be sure
- The conference hotel is a DGN. (More about this later)

Other Options

- Orlando has tons of hotel options
 - Just because Disney does not “approve” them does not mean they are not awesome.
 - You can save tons of money by staying “outside the bubble”
- You can also rent entire homes through Airbnb, VRBO and numerous other sites. These often come with great amenities at an amazing price.

The Conference Hotel

- The Hilton Orlando Disney Springs
- A Disney Good Neighbor Hotel - Transportation to the parks and early entry
- Very close to Disney Springs with tons to do, see, eat, and buy.
- Of course this would not be a NOAH trip without a great pool
