




## The Parks







#### Tickets

- Base ticket is \$109 for a one day ticket
  - \$80 for Volcano Bay
- Park to Park is a \$55 add on
  - You can easily do both parks in one day
- The more days you play, the more you will save

## AAP, Rider Swap, and Express Pass

#### **AAP Pass**

- AAP stands for Access Assistance Pass.
- It entitles a person holding the pass and several others in their party to reserve a return time equal to the current wait time on a ride. If the wait time is under thirty minutes they can ride immediately.
- Once they return they wait in a significantly reduced line.
- It is good because you are not in line but bad because you miss the pre-show.
- You register for this with Guest Services

#### Rider Swap

- This ensure that everyone in a party can ride a given ride even if a member of their group cannot
- Simply ask a cast member for a rider swap and they will instruct you on how that attraction is handling it.
- The entire party waits in line then the adult and which ever kids can ride do so. At the end, the adult with whatever kids can ride go while the first adult can exit the attraction.

## **Express Pass**

- \$80 for single Ride
  - You get to skip the line at each attraction once
- \$110 for Multi Ride
  - You can skip the line an unlimited number of times

- An outdoor eating, shopping, entertainment, and hotel district on Universal property
- Serviced by boats and busses



## Transportation

#### On Site

- When on Universal property, transportation is provided free of charge
- All forms of transportation run just frequently enough but it will take a bit of time to get to where you want to go
- Sometimes a big part of the fun is getting there
- On Foot, Bus, and Boat

#### Universal Hotels

- Universal has seven hotels
- The highest tear hotels give you express pass as part of your stay - Potentially a huge savings

  - You can save tons of money by staying "outside the bubble"
- You can also rent entire homes through Airbnb, VRBO and numerous other sites. These often come with great amenities at an amazing price.

#### The Conference Hotel

- The Hilton Orlando Disney Springs
- A Disney Good Neighbor Hotel Transportation to the parks and early entry at Disney (not Universal)
- Very close to Disney Springs with tons to do, see, eat, and buy.
